

MANSUR'S ANATOMY (TASHRİH-İ BADAN-İ İNSAN)

Mansur İbn Muhammad İbn Ahmad İbn Yusuf İbn İlyas was a Persian scholar from Shiraz who lived between the late 14th and early 15th century. He was an anatomist and physician who published an illustrated text containing twodimentional colored figures of the human body. The book known as Mansur's Anatomy (Tashrih-i Badan-i İnsan) is considered the first colored atlas of its kind in the history of medicine.
